The 1st4sport Level 2 Award in First Aid for Sport (QCF) provides learners aged 14 years and over with the knowledge, understanding and skills required to be able to respond successfully and safely to accidents, illnesses and injuries as they occur in a sporting environment. When completed in partnership with a Health and Safety Executive (HSE) approved emergency aid qualification, learners will be able to work as a first-aider for a sporting event, with confidence that they are prepared for the range of injuries and illnesses likely to occur in such an environment.

### Prerequisites

Learners are required to be at least 14 years of age to attend the programme of learning.

NB: This qualification does not include cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). Learners and recognised centres should note that in order for an individual to practise first aid for sporting activities, they are required to hold a minimum of a current HSE-approved Emergency First Aid qualification. It is strongly recommended they also attend a safeguarding and protecting children workshop.
