Developed in partnership with the National Source group for Badminton<sup>1</sup>, the 1st4sport Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Badminton (QCF) provides learners aged 18 and over with an opportunity to study and be assessed on both the theoretical and practical aspects of coaching badminton. They will develop their knowledge of how to effectively plan, conduct and evaluate a series of badminton coaching sessions in a safe, ethical and effective manner. The Certificate qualifies holders to coach the skills and techniques of the sport of badminton to players of all ages.

### Prerequisites

Prior to the certification, learners are required to:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age
- hold the 1st4sport Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Badminton or recognised equivalent<sup>2</sup>.

<sup>2</sup> Equivalent qualifications include the *BADMINTONscotland* Instructors Award, the *BADMINTON* England Level 1 or The Welsh Badminton Union Leaders Award. Any qualifications away from these recognised equivalences will be dealt with per individual application.

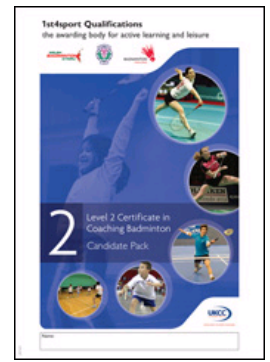
### Materials
