Learners are required to:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age prior to certification
- hold the 1st4sport Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Basketball or the 1st4sport Level 1 Award in Coaching Basketball (OCF) or equivalent
- have evidence of having successfully attended the sports coach UK 'Safeguarding and Protecting Children' workshop or equivalent prior to certification
- have evidence of having successfully attended an appointed person's first-aid course or equivalent prior to certification.

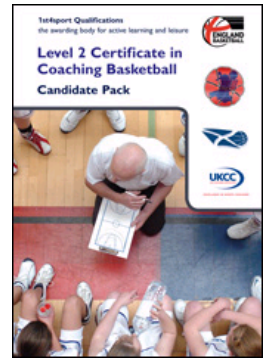
