Developed in partnership with the National Source Group for Netball¹, the 1st4sport Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Netball (QCF) is designed to provide learners with an introduction to the processes and principles of coaching netball to adults and children. The Certificate offers an opportunity for netball coaches to be supported in developing their knowledge of how to effectively plan, conduct and evaluate a series of netball coaching sessions in a safe, ethical and effective manner. Those who complete this Certificate will be able to work as a netball coach, either alone or as part of a larger coaching team.

Prerequisites

Learners are required to:

- be at least 18 years of age
- have attended a recognised child protection/duty of care training course prior to certification
- have attended a recognised emergency first-aid course prior to certification.

It is highly recommended that learners hold the 1st4sport Level 1 Award in Coaching Netball (QCF) or equivalent.
