The 1st4sport Level 3 NVQ in Spectator Safety (L3NVQSS) is an occupational qualification that provides learners with an opportunity to be assessed, over a period of time, for both the practical and theoretical aspects of steward supervision in the workplace. The qualification is ideal for those who have already completed the [1st4sport Level 2 NVQ in Spectator Safety](#) or the [1st4sport Level 2 NVQ Certificate in Spectator Safety](#) and are looking to develop their knowledge and skills since completing either of those qualifications.

Nationally recognised, this qualification provides confirmation of a steward's ability to supervise those working at live spectator events.

Who is the Qualification for?

Anyone over 18 years old who wishes to become a fully qualified steward supervisor at live spectator events. The qualification is ideally suited to those who have completed any of the following qualifications and wish to confirm their ability to supervise those working at live spectator events safely and effectively:
