Developed in partnership with the National Source Group for Badminton<sup>1</sup>, the 1st4sport Level 3 Certificate in Coaching Badminton (QCF) is designed to provide learners aged 18 and over with the necessary skills, knowledge and experience to deliver an annual coaching programme to either adults or young people. The Certificate offers an opportunity for learners to effectively apply the principles of performance profiling, goal setting and designing, planning, delivering and evaluating an annual badminton coaching programme. It also aims to support learners in creating an effective coaching environment, establishing supportive working relationships and managing the behaviour of players and others.

### Prerequisites

To register, learners are required to:

- be at least 18 years of age,
- hold the 1st4sport Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Badminton or home country equivalent.

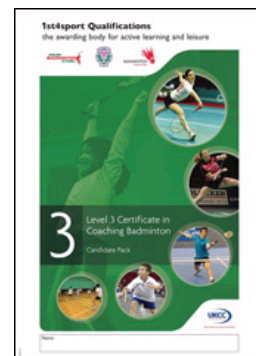
## QCF
