Developed in partnership with the UK Source Group for Volleyball¹, the 1st4sport Level 1 Award in Coaching Volleyball (QCF) is the first qualification on the volleyball coaching ladder. The qualification is designed to provide learners aged 16 and over with an introduction to the practical and theoretical aspects of coaching volleyball. The foundation level of knowledge recognised in this qualification will enable them to develop an understanding of the safe, ethical and effective coaching of volleyball. Those who complete this Award will be able to assist in the delivery of volleyball coaching sessions to adults and children.
