Prerequisites

Learners are required to be aged 14 years or over, prior to registration.

Structure

The qualification is divided into the following units:

*Each credit is equivalent to 10 hours of learning time. When learning time is not exactly in a multiple of 10, it must be rounded up or down as credit can only be represented in whole numbers (*14 hours of learning would be rounded down to represent 1 credit, 17 hours of learning would be rounded up to represent 2 credits*).
