There are 55 recommended learning hours for learners to complete the qualification, of which 43 are guided learning hours.

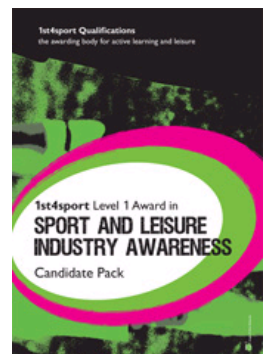
