
I am writing to you to provide the University of Worcester support for the newly developed *1st4sport Level 3 Diploma in Sport and Physical Activities*, which has been designed to meet the requirements for an Applied General qualification.

University of Worcester offers a range of sport related degree programmes for which this qualification can contribute towards a learner meeting the undergraduate admission requirements for the following programmes. Level 3 Awards can be considered as part requirements for Students wishing to enter all of the Sports Coaching Awards, specifically, BSc in Sports Coaching Science and BSc in Sports Coaching and Disability.

Our undergraduate course provision in Sports and Coaching related areas is very strong and our intake for the 2015 year is expected to be around 550 students. We have grown consistently for the last 15 years and the Institute of Sport and Exercise offers a range of single and joint honours courses. Typically our courses require 280 UCAS points or equivalent for successful entry. Our Students display both practical and theoretical backgrounds and this Diploma would fit well with this ethos.
