<b>Qualification Overview:</b>	This qualification introduces learners to the skills and knowledge required to deliver linked and progressive cable/wakeboarding coaching sessions to a group of participants over time.

<b>Progression Opportunities</b>	Successful learners are eligible to seek employment in appropriate paid or voluntary coaching roles. Learners achieving this qualification may progress on to the 1st4sport Level 3 Certificate in Coaching Wakeboarding.						

Qualification Objective
<b>What does this qualification cover?</b>
This qualification introduces learners to the principles/practice of safe, ethical and effective management and coaching of cable wakeboarding sessions to adults and young people in an appropriate environment.
<b>Who is the qualification for?</b>
This qualification is designed for learners who wish to become qualified in coaching Cable Wakeboarding for future employment.
<b>Who supports this qualification?</b>
The qualification is recognised as the industry standard level 2 qualification for cable wakeboarding coaches by British Water Ski & Wakeboarding and UK Coaching.
Qualification Progression
<b>What future education could this qualification lead to?</b>
Learners could progress onto the 1st4sport Level 3 Certificate in Coaching Wakeboarding. Alternatively, the skills and knowledge developed may also be used to enable learners to progress to other industry-relevant qualifications in coaching sport, physical activity, activity leadership, supporting PE in school sport and sports development.
<b>What future employment could this qualification lead to?</b>
This qualification may lead to paid employment or unpaid voluntary roles in coaching wakeboarding, either working independently or as part of a coaching team. Other roles that the learner may consider exploring include Activity Leader, Official, or Sports Volunteer.

Qualification Achievement
<b>Entry Requirements for the Qualification</b>
The recognised centre is required to conduct an initial assessment of learners to ensure that the pre-requisites to registration and certification are considered and the outcome recorded during the application process.
Prior to registration learners are required to:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• be aged 17 years or over</li> <li>• have experience in at least one discipline (water skiing and wakeboarding) or hold the BWSW Instructors Award or equivalent</li> <li>• have experience in driving for water skiers/wakeboarders</li> <li>• be able to communicate effectively in English (this includes listening, speaking, reading and writing).</li> </ul>
Prior to receiving their certificate, it is mandatory for learners to complete all BWSW's coach licensing pre-requisites:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• hold a current BWSW Membership</li> <li>• hold the BWSW Ski Boat Driver Award</li> <li>• have attended a recognised safeguarding and protecting children workshop</li> <li>• have attended a first aid course</li> <li>• have completed an Enhanced Disclosure Check (the most relevant for your country)</li> </ul>
<b>How is the Qualification Achieved?</b>
The recognised centre must ensure that the learners' knowledge and competence is assessed against the assessment criteria of the qualification in line with the Assessment Specification, as outlined in the Qualification Handbook.
<b>What will be assessed?</b>
Learners must:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• complete written tasks contained within the 1st4sport Learner Portfolio</li> <li>• be practically observed delivering coaching</li> </ul>

### How will it be assessed?

This qualification contains a range of units to be completed by the learner. Each unit is comprised of a number of learning outcomes and identified assessment criteria to be completed.

Learning Outcomes that begin 'The learner will **understand...**' will be assessed through theory based activities.

Learning Outcomes that begin 'The learner will **be able to...**' are assessed through practical activities.

For example:

### Qualification Delivery

#### What workforce is needed to be able to deliver this qualification?

The recognised centre is required to have a qualified and competent qualification workforce in place which includes.

- a qualification administrator
- a qualification coordinator
- an appropriately qualified tutor/ assessor:
- an appropriately qualified internal quality assurer (IQA)

#### What facilities are needed to be able to deliver this qualification?

The recognised centre is required to have one or more delivery sites which contain facilities to support the programme of learning and assessment. These must comply with health and safety regulations and have in place appropriate access arrangements. All training and/or assessment sites must include the following facilities:

- if in the UK, be a BWSW Affiliated Centre
- have access to a boat and water close to a theory space
- a theory space for up to 10 learners which includes multimedia facilities, flip charts and flip chart pens.

The weather and environment must be conducive to learning; lighting and temperature appropriate to the participant and learner needs.

#### What equipment is needed to be able to deliver this qualification?

The recognised centre is required to have equipment in place to facilitate the full programme of learning and assessment which must comply with accepted health and safety practice for Water Skiing and Wakeboarding and must include at least one set of the following:

- wakeboards
- wetsuits and buoyancy aids for each learner attending the course of training.

The recognised centre must ensure that all learners and persons being coached wear appropriate sports apparel as mentioned earlier.

What qualification materials support this qualification?
